SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The National Asian Peace Officers' Association (NAPOA), Pan Pacific Law Enforcement Association (PANPAC), and Filipino American Law Enforcement Organization-San Diego (FALEO-SD) are pleased to announce its 2014 joint scholarship program. It is open to all high school seniors or enrolled college students that meet the listed requirements.

The annual scholarship awardees will be awarded up to \$1,000.00 and will be presented to qualifying and deserving students of character, who demonstrate a sincere desire to further their education.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior with a full time attendance record or a continuing student at a University or College.
- 2. Applicant must be a dependant of a NAPOA, PANPAC, FALEO-SD member or a member of the San Diego Asian Youth Organization.
- 3. Applicant must have maintained a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 throughout high school or a minimum G.P.A. while enrolled at a University or College.
- 4. Scholarship application must include all of the following documents:
 - a) Completed application
 - b) High School Transcript or College Transcript
 - c) Letter of recommendation (Community Leader)
 - d) Applicant must submit a one-page essay expressing, "The Challenges, Changes and Opportunities I have experienced and why this scholarship is important to me."
- 5. Applicant must submit a completed scholarship application along with the required documents and mail them to: Attn: PANPAC, P.O. BOX 122924, San Diego, CA 92112. The application must be postmarked no later than Friday, August 8, 2014. Finalists will be notified by telephone or email. The scholarships will be awarded at the NAPOA Banquet and Awards Ceremony.
